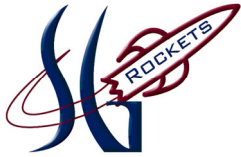

**SUBJECT:** Proposed BusPatrol Contract

---

We have been actively working with our new student transportation contractor, Krise Transportation, technology vendor BusPatrol, and the Northern York Regional Police Department on a new system that is being used to improve student safety and support recent stop-arm camera enforcement laws.

Briefly, cameras mounted on our busses will be able to “capture” drivers who do not comply with the law requiring traffic to come to a complete stop when students embark/disembark at bus stops. The cameras system will also be part of the internal video monitoring system. The proposal has cost benefits to the District that will be reviewed with the Board. Additional information on this technology will be shared with you at the June 28<sup>th</sup> meeting.

The District has received and is reviewing a proposed contract with BusPatrol. The proposed contract is currently in rough-draft form and under review by the District’s solicitor. Our plan is to share a copy of the final contract with board members for review and consideration as soon as it is received. Following the board’s review, an action item is anticipated for inclusion with July 19<sup>th</sup> board meeting items. In light of the critical nature of these safety services for our students and the summer meeting schedule of the Board, we appreciate the Board’s continued flexibility with the timing of this anticipated action.
