- I. Presentation of Visitation Experiences –
  - A. Southwestern – Dr. Cugliari, Mr. Sengia, Mrs. Maurer, Mr. Enck
    1. Student Council proposed cell phone policy to Board.
      - Started with a “trial period” at the end of last year before implementing policy the following year.
    2. Use of cell phones
      - May only be used during specific times
        - May be used before 8:20 am.
        - During lunch periods
        - Not used during instructional time.
    3. Cell phone abuse is less of an issue since policy was put in place.
    4. Concerns
      - Students taking pictures of other students and posting on social media networks.
      - Slight instances of phones being stolen from cafeteria tables during lunch.
  - B. Northeastern – Mr. Cable, Mrs. Henning, Mr. Copeland, Mr. Becker, Mr. Enck
    1. Doesn't have a policy in place at the present time, but instead has a set of guidelines.
    2. Use of electronic devices
      - Only used in classrooms at teachers' discretion.
      - Did not allow phones in hallways and cafeteria.
    3. Management of phone
      - Observed classrooms utilizing smartphones for Poll Everywhere applications, QR codes, Twitter, etc.
      - Not an issue for students who do not own a phone to still be productive in the classroom. Students without phones were just paired up with students who owned one.
      - Phones sit on corner of desks when they are not being used during instructional time.
