- I. Reviewed Policy 237
 - A. Solicitor's recommendations
 1. Authority
 - better define school sponsored events
 2. Electronic Images
 - added confiscation of devices
 - spell out what can and cannot be recorded
 3. Privacy
 - registration of devices – students will not be required to register their device with the district

- II. Rewrite of Policy 815
 - A. Policy title changed from *Acceptable Use* to ***Responsible Use***.
 - B. Changed terminology on page 3 from *technical devices* to ***personal electronic devices***.
 - C. Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) – requires that K-12 schools use internet filters and implement other measure to protect children from harmful online content as a condition for the receipt of certain federal funding (E-Rate discounts).
Effective July 1, 2012 – states that along with providing a certain level of protection, schools will also provide a certain level of safe internet training.

- III. Handbook Changes
 - A. Teachers at each building level provided input for their respective building handbook.

- IV. Final Report Feedback
 - A. Two additional bullets added under Drawbacks to Recommendation
 - Frustrations related to technology malfunctions with various types of devices.

- Parent and student reaction to some teachers allowing the devices in their respective classrooms and some do not.

- A. High school is planning to offer parent training at their Back to School Night.
